The Trust was extremely disappointed with the chaotic scenes at Ibrox on Tuesday, when Champions League tickets went on sale. Whilst we agree that it was sensible for the Club to only sell sets of tickets for all three Group matches, the limit of six per person was far too high, and the many complaints we have received regarding stewarding indicates that the Club were ill-prepared for this operation.

A Trust Spokesman commented, "Had they seen fit to consult us on this matter, this shambles would have been avoided. Demand for these tickets was always going to exceed supply, but the cavalier manner in which those queuing – some for many hours – were treated, leaves a lot to be desired."
