User-friendly fixtures? – We don't think so!

The Rangers Supporters Trust today expressed its concerns about the seemingly cavalier way match fixtures now ignore the needs of the paying public.

RST Chairman, Colin Glass, commented, "Unbelievably, Rangers only have three Saturday 3pm kick-offs between now and the end of this year – a schedule which seems to pay scant regard to the preferences of the regular supporter.

"Whilst this is in part due to our participation in the UEFA Cup, rather than the far more lucrative and prestigious Champions League, it goes completely against the wishes of our members, which were expressed both in the recent Fans' Survey, and also by way of a Trust policy adopted at our first AGM, when we sought a minimum of $\frac{3}{4}$ of Rangers' league fixtures to kick-off at 3pm on a Saturday.

"This is not just about self-interest – too many Sunday fixtures is not good news for families either, or indeed society as a whole."
