In particular, we are hoping to hear details of the restoration of some of our previously owned assets, but providing no further reduction in our most valuable remaining assets is proposed, the Trust will heave a huge collective sigh of relief.

A Trust spokesman commented, "At our own AGM, a motion opposing the ownership of Ibrox Stadium by any party other than Rangers FC was passed unanimously.

“Whatever moves are proposed, we could never countenance the ownership of the Stadium being held by anyone other than the Club, even if the carrot of impediments to our on-field performance being lifted was offered by a fresh injection of capital – after all, there are many other ways of attracting investment which would be far more acceptable to fans and shareholders alike.

“I think any Rangers Director foolish enough to propose such a scheme would need to head for cover at the earliest opportunity.”

The aim of the Rangers Supporters Trust, now Scotland's largest with 1,300 Members - all of whom are Rangers shareholders, is to encourage and facilitate supporters to buy and hold shares in the Club. The intention is to influence future club decisions and deliver greater ownership to its loyal supporters.
