The Rangers Supporters Trust today welcomed the report issued by the All Party Parliamentary Football Group, which called for, among other things, the restoration of 3pm kick-off times on a Saturday, the introduction of “Fit & Proper” tests for club directors, and, most importantly, proper recognition by football clubs of Supporters Trusts.

A spokesman commented, “Whilst we have not yet had the chance to study the report in full, it is obviously encouraging to note that MPs of all parties at least recognise the depth of concern felt by supporters of virtually all clubs as to the future of the game, and that Supporters Trusts, which are, by definition, usually set up by a club’s most committed supporters, have the best interests of their club, and the community which it serves, at the top of their Agenda.

“No doubt this Report will be one of the main topics of discussion at our next Open Day in Ibrox Primary School before we play Hibs a week on Saturday.”

He concluded, "It is good to see Parliament seeking to return the People's game to the People."
