Trust expresses disgust at recent media slurs

The Rangers Supporters Trust today condemned the recent spate of attacks on the Club by certain journalists, whom we feel are using their employers purely as a vehicle to further their own personal agendas.

Not wishing to give added publicity to any of the main culprits – all Scottish football fans will know who they are – the latest attack came only this morning from a writer, one of whose obvious frustrations is his inability to obtain interviews from any Rangers players or officials.

The presentation of subjective and unsubstantiated “facts” and rebuttal of any coherent counterargument imply personal vendettas and prejudices which are overruling impartial journalism. We believe this is healthy for neither Scottish football nor society at large.
