Fans' Survey results to be published this Sunday, following Trust's 2nd AGM

The Trust has just completed the analysis of the most comprehensive survey of Rangers fans' views ever conducted, and will publish the responses received to all 64 questions this coming Sunday. The Survey was open to both members and non-members of the Trust, although the majority of the respondents were Trust members.

Among the main conclusions, which will be finely detailed, were the following:-

- 94% of Trust members and 90% of non-members felt that communications between the Rangers FC plc board and the fans was bad.
- 89% of Trust members and 78% of non-members think the club does not care about the fans
- 84% of Trust members and 90% of non-members think that Rangers should be playing in a British League
- 91% of Trust members and 82% of non-members think that the Trust should have a seat on the Board of Directors
- 91% of Trust members and 84% of non-members felt that Rangers live TV games should still kick off at 3pm on a Saturday

A Trust spokesman commented, "Clearly, the results of this Survey should give the Rangers Board some real cause for concern, although it was not all bad news for the Club, by any means. For example, the view from each fan's own seat scored over 8/10 for both members and non-members.

"Twelve of the questions invited a rating on a scale of 1/10, and significantly, but not

surprisingly, the area where the fans felt most let down is by the club's PR, which scored less than 2 from Trust members, and less than 3 from non-members.

"75% of Trust Members surveyed were season ticket holders, and 73% of non-members also had season tickets, so those who took the trouble to respond tend to be among the most passionate Rangers fans, so we hope the Club do take heed of this Survey, and yes, we shall be sending them a copy of the full results."

One of the key aims of the Rangers Supporters Trust is to encourage and facilitate supporters to buy and hold shares in the Club. The intention is to influence future club decisions and deliver greater ownership to its loyal supporters.
